- \$40 FAMILY FEE - TARGET PACKAGE CONSISTS OF ONE SET OF TARGETS (which may be shared) FOR HUSBAND, WIFE, AND CHILDREN UP TO AGE 18; EXTRA TARGETS MAY BE PURCHASED SEPARATELY FOR \$ 3 EACH. (Example: If a mother and daughter both want to shoot the "Grinning Bear" target, an extra target may be purchased for \$3.)
- ANY ADDITIONAL REENTRY TARGETS WILL BE \$1.00 EACH.
- CAMPING FEES ARE INCLUDED WITH THE \$40 REGISTRATION FEE. (FRONTIER HERITAGE NOT INCLUDED.)

7.	6 BULL SLUG (REVERSED)	BEST 5 OUT OF 6	25 YDS

- **MATCHES 1 THROUGH 7 MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE LUNCH BREAK IS CALLED. NO MORNING MATCHES CAN BE TURNED IN AFTER THE LUNCH BREAK.**
- **30 MINUTE LUNCH BREAK (SATURDAY ONLY)**
- **SUNDAY THERE WILL BE ONLY 7 RELAYS WITH NO LUNCH BREAK.**

# Important Information

Please read prior to shooting to eliminate problems before they arise!

## Proud and Out Rule:

When a competitor has three first, three seconds, and three thirds they will be considered **PROUD AND OUT**.

*Example:* A competitor receives a first place score, but already has three firsts – he or she is moved to second place and the second place score is moved to first. If the competitor already has three seconds, they will be moved to third. When the competitor has three first, three seconds, and three thirds they will be considered **PROUD AND OUT**.

## Rules and Regulations:

1. This shoot will be subject to the rules and regulations of the NMLRA.
2. Safety is of paramount importance at every shoot. Everyone is responsible for following safe gun handling rules and precautions.
3. All Junior and Sub Junior shooters must be supervised by an adult.
4. Each competitor is responsible for scoring his or her own targets before turning them in. The targets will be checked for accuracy by an official scorer.
5. Each competitor is responsible for checking his own targets to ensure the proper competitor number is displayed.
6. Please be courteous and helpful to all of the volunteers who are making this shoot possible.
7. The Range Officers decisions are final.
8. The Scorers decisions are final.
9. If you have a problem with your equipment or shoot on another shooter's target, you must notify a Range Officer immediately.
10. You may protest your scores before or during the time stipulated at the shoot.
11. Registration will open at 7:30 a.m.
12. Saturday matches 1 thru 7 must be shot before the lunch break.
13. Relays will be 30 minutes for offhand, and 45 minutes for bench.
14. You may post more than one target per relay on the offhand range if space permits. (Example: an offhand and flint target may be posted at the same time). Check with the range officials on the other ranges.
15. Have a great time, meet some new friends, and let us know how we can improve the shoot for next year!
