

New Fee Structure for NMLRA Instructors and Trainers

All NMLRA Instructors and Trainers will receive the student packet and book discount by purchasing the student packet, which includes the book or the book by itself at \$10.00 instead of purchasing the materials separately (the book is \$12.00 retail).

For Trainers teaching the Instructor Course, \$25.00 for each instructor candidate enrolled who is an NMLRA member and \$50.00 for each candidate who is not an NMLRA member will be charged and mailed to the NMLRA. This administrative fee will include the cost of the candidate's instructor fee for a period of two years. Any NRA Muzzleloading Instructor or Training Counselor who wishes to become an NMLRA Muzzleloading Instructor or Trainer will also pay these fees for their initial two year certification. NMLRA membership is not required to be an NMLRA Instructor, but NMLRA membership is required to be an NMLRA Trainer.

All NMLRA Trainers will pay a fee of \$10.00 for a two year certification. All NMLRA Instructors who are NMLRA members will also pay a \$10.00 fee for a two year certification. Any NMLRA Instructor who is not an NMLRA member will pay a \$20.00 fee for a two year certification. This fee structure will take effect immediately for all NMLRA Instructors and Trainers. For current NMLRA Instructors and Trainers the new fees will take effect when their current certification expires.

Any NMLRA Instructor (that has been trained in all three disciplines) who is also an NRA Muzzleloading Rifle, ML Pistol or ML Shotgun Instructor and needs to pre-qualify in the discipline(s) that they are lacking to get their new NRA Muzzleloading rating, should be recognized by NRA as qualified for the new NRA Muzzleloading rating. All you have to do is copy your current NMLRA credentials and e-mail them along with your NRA Instructor number to John Howard at NRA HQ (JHoward@nrahq.org) and your rating will be upgraded to the new NRA Muzzleloading discipline.
