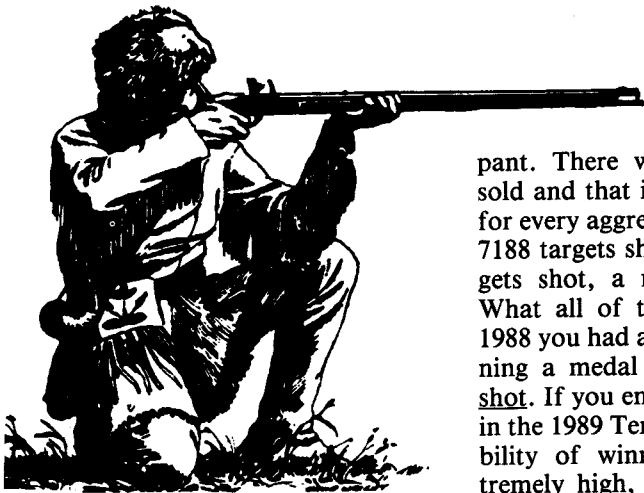


# 1988 Levi Garrett



The 1987 Territorial Program Report generated many positive letters and comments. Therefore, we have compiled all the scores for the 1988 Territorial Program and they are included in this report. Briefly, for those of you who have never competed in the Territorials, these are aggregate scores and are the same as those that you would shoot at Friendship. There are a few exceptions, but you should relate to the standard 200 point Friendship Aggregate.

The first set of scores represent the average shot for each of the aggregates for all of the Territorials in 1988. The scores are arranged in descending order ranging from the most popular to the least popular aggregate.

Just like the 1987 scores, these are not very frightening and your chances for winning one or more medals at a Territorial are very good. In fact, 3372 medals were available to 1019 participants in the 1988 program. Therefore, 3.3 medals were awarded for every partici-

pant. There were 1682 aggregates sold and that interprets two medals for every aggregate sold. There were 7188 targets shot; for every 2.1 targets shot, a medal was awarded. What all of this means is that in 1988 you had a 50-50 chance of winning a medal on every target you shot. If you enter several aggregates in the 1989 Territorials, your probability of winning a medal is extremely high, so don't be bashful; shoot several aggregates in the 1989 Territorial program that you attend.

I have again averaged the qualifying scores of each of the Territorials, adjusted each aggregate to a 200 point score and have come up with a composite score and ranking for all of the Territorials in 1988. This tells you how well your Territorial shooters did when compared to the others...

If you want your state to fare better in the 1989 ranking, the answer is simple. It does not depend on how many good shooters you have at your Territorial. Think about it, the more aggregates you sell at your Territorial the less a high or low score can affect your Territorial's composite ranking. More participants shooting more aggregates is the answer to a higher ranking. Lets get out there and shoot the 1989 Territorials!
